**Having been held three times since 2015, the DEKRA Commercial Vehicle Outlook Conference has established itself as the central platform for dialog within the transportation and logistics industry. The next conference is scheduled for November 30 and December 1, 2021, which will see it held as a hybrid event for the first time, with attendees able to join in person in Berlin, Germany, as well as online.**

The event is held every two years and brings together top-class experts from the automotive and automotive supply industries, the policymaking world, and academia. This year, the program will be split into three topic areas, which will be explored in tandem: commercial vehicle technology, digital transformation, and the last mile.

In total, the event organizers are expecting more than 350 experts, academics, and top managers from well-known companies in the commercial vehicles industry – including many from international businesses such as Continental, Dachser, Daimler Truck, Fleetboard Logistics, Hyundai, Goodyear Dunlop Tires, Knorr-Bremse, Kögel, Krone, Quantron SAF-Holland, Rhenus, Scania, Schmitz Cargobull, Shell, Volkswagen, and ZF Friedrichshafen. Also in attendance will be speakers from a range of different associations and European organizations.

In addition, the European Commercial Vehicle Safety Award will again be presented at this year's Outlook Conference. Each year, the award is conferred to individuals whose professional activities have played an especially significant role in enhancing the safety of commercial vehicles. It is handed out by DEKRA, the German Road Safety Council (DVR), and the European Association for Accident Research and Accident Analysis (EVU).
